

Decision No. 28535

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY and NEVADA IRRIGATION DISTRICT for an order of the Railroad Commission authorizing applicants to enter into an agreement, in words and figures as written in the form therefor, which is annexed hereto, providing for the withdrawal of certain District water from Pacific Gas and Electric Company's South Yuba Canal.

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Nevada Irrigation District having made application to the Railroad Commission of the State of California requesting approval of a written agreement in accordance with the words and figures as written in the form therefor attached to the application herein and marked Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1, said agreement providing, among other things, for the withdrawal and diversion from Pacific Gas and Electric Company's South Yuba Canal at the intake therein of the Zeibright pipe line leading therefrom to the Newmont Mining Company's Zeibright Mine, located on Bear River below said canal, such quantities of Nevada Irrigation District's water as said District shall from time to time elect, at a rate not to exceed fifty (50) miner's inches,⁽¹⁾ to meet increased requirements of said mine, and it appearing that this is not a

1. For the purpose of this agreement, a miner's inch shall be one-fortieth (1/40th) of a cubic foot of water per second.

matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Nevada Irrigation District be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the withdrawal and diversion of water substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1 attached to the application herein and made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
