FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant, on January 30, 1936, filed with the Commission a certified copy of an agreement between the State of California and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, covering the terms of construction and maintenance of the Calwa Overhead in Fresno County, as authorized by this Commission in its Decision No. 28372, dated November 18, 1935.

Paragraph 11 of Article III of this agreement recites that the agreement shall not become effective until and unless approved by this Commission.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that said agreement complies with the requirements of the Commission's Decision No. 28372, and should be approved,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the agreement entered into between the State of California and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, dated November 14, 1935, relating to the construction and maintenance of the Calwa Overhead Crossing with the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at Calwa, Fresno County, State of California, be and

it is hereby approved.
