J. E. Johnson and P. A. Pesula, co-partners operating the Weott Light Plant, at Weott, Humboldt County, having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to transfer to Charles L. East their electric plant including two engines, two generators, meters, transformers and distribution lines, and their franchise to operate, for the sum of \$4,000.00, payment to be made, in accordance with the terms of a conditional contract of sale dated January 1, 1935, in the amount of \$280.00 upon execution of the contract, \$200.00 on or before March 1, 1935 and the balance in installments of \$50.00 per month or more, with final payment to be made two years from the date of the contract, or January 1, 1937, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted, as herein provided.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. E. Johnson and P. A. Pesula be, and they hereby are, authorized to transfer to Charles L. East the properties comprising the Weott Light Plant referred to in

this proceeding, such transfer to be made in accordance with the terms of the conditional contract of sale dated January 1, 1935, filed in this proceeding.
