O P I N I O N

A. Machomich, doing business as A. Machomich Stage, has made application to this Commission for an order authorizing him to discontinue all service for the automotive transportation as a highway common carrier of passengers and baggage between Blairsden, Gold Lake Camp, sometimes known as Gold Lake Lodge as authorized in Decision No. 14779, Application No. 10977, and for a further order revoking his operating right.

As justification for such authority applicant alleges that during the year of 1935 the receipts from his operations amounted to \$47.00, and that during such period he paid out as expenses for such operations the sum of \$59.12.

Applicant further alleges that the service rendered is for the convenience of guests arriving at and departing from the summer resort known as Gold Lake Lodge and that he is the sole owner of such resort, and further alleges that if the petition for discontinuance is granted he will undertake to provide transportation for such guests free of any charge, either direct or indirect.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A. Machomich be, and he is hereby, authorized to discontinue and abandon all automotive service for the transportation as a highway common carrier of passengers and baggage between Blairsden and Gold Lake Camp.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time schedules now on file with this Commission therefor, be, and they are, hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 14779 dated April 10, 1925 in Application No. 10977 be, and it is hereby, revoked and annulled.
