IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph one of the order in

1936, enter into an agreement of merger substantially  
in the same form as the agreement filed in this proceed-  
ing as Exhibit No. 2"

Service Company of California may, on or before June 1,  
1936, enter into an agreement of merger substantially  
in the same form as the agreement filed in this proceed-  
ing as Exhibit No. 2.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that paragraph three of  
the order in said Decision No. 28457 reading as follows:-

" American States Water Service Company of California may  
issue at not less than par on or before March 1, 1936,  
\$3,400,000.00 of its first mortgage bonds, Series A  
4-1/2%, due October 1, 1960, and use said bonds for the  
purpose of paying the indebtedness referred to in the  
foregoing opinion"

be, and it hereby is, amended so as to read--

American States Water Service Company of California may issue at not less than par on or before June 1, 1936, \$3,400,000.00 of its first mortgage bonds, Series A 4-1/2%, due October 1, 1960 and use said bonds for the purpose of paying the indebtedness referred to in the foregoing opinion.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in said Decision No. 28457, dated December 21, 1935, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
