O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on February 26, 1936, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency stations of Sholim, Hanna and Cypress Lawn, located on its San Bruno Branch in San Mateo County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business was transacted at said non-agency stations for more than two years last past, and that, in its opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency stations is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Sholim, Hanna and Cypress Lawn, in San Mateo County, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency names from its station records; and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
