O R D E R

In Decision No. 12173 in the above entitled proceeding, the Commission ordered Southern Pacific Company to protect the crossing of Embarcadero Road with its tracks in the City of Palo Alto with a human flagman on duty between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M. daily.

It appears that said crossing is now being eliminated by separation of grades, under authority granted by the Commission in Application No. 20284, and that said protection is no longer necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order in Decision No. 12173, dated June 5, 1923, in Case No. 1899, is hereby rescinded.
