SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 28390 on the 24th Supplemental Application of the Pacific Electric Railway Company in the above entitled proceeding, applicant was authorized to reroute its so-called Hollywood-North Hollywood motor coach line for a trial period of ninety (90) days from November 25, 1935.

On March 12, 1936, applicant filed with the Commission a request for an extension of ninety (90) days in which to continue this trial operation, stating that it had not yet come to a conclusion as to whether or not it would be desirable to make the rerouting permanent.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the extension requested should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to continue the rerouting of its so-called Hollywood-North Hollywood motor coach line, as authorized in said Decision No. 28390, dated November 25, 1935, up to and including May 25, 1936, subject to the same conditions as Decision No. 28390.

In all other respects Decision No. 28390 is reaffirmed

and in full force and effect.
