SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, on February 25, 1936, filed a supplemental application herein asking that paragraph I of the order in Decision No. 28561, dated February 10, 1936, on Application 20295, be amended so as to permit the retention of Houser station as a carload station.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that said supplemental application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph I of the order in Decision No. 28561, dated February 10, 1936, on Application 20295, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"I. Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Hauser located on its Venice Short Line, in Los Angeles County, State of California, as a less-than-carload station, but to retain it as a carload station."

In all other respects, Decision No. 28561, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
