SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The County of Orange having on March 11, 1936, requested, in writing, an extension of time from the time limit mentioned in Decision No. 27096, dated May 28, 1934, and subsequently extended by Decision No. 28013, dated June 3, 1935, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the County of Orange is hereby authorized to continue to maintain a crossing of a public road at separated grades, with impaired clearances, under the Newport Beach Line of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, identified as Crossing No. 6E-35.60-B, to and including December 1, 1936; provided, however, that within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, applicant shall file evidence of consent of Pacific Electric Railway Company to said extension of time.

Applicant shall continue to maintain the protective devices described in condition (5) of Decision No. 27096 and

shall, at its sole expense, on or before December 1, 1936,
close and barricade to public use and travel the above
identified crossing.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
