IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western Truck Lines, Ltd., be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of passengers and express between Desert Center and Parker Damsite as authorized by Decision No. 27742 dated February 11, 1935 on Application No. 19100 until October 1, 1936, provided that such discontinuance shall be made effective only after one day's notice to the Commission and the public as evidenced by the posting of proper notices at its terminals and in its busses and a filing with the Commission of a proper tariff supplement and time schedule showing service suspension as authorized herein, and provided further, applicant shall elect during said period, to either restore said service on or before the expiration of said period, or to relinquish its operating right.
