O P I N I O N

David E. Covey, operating an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property as a highway common carrier between Redding and Fern and intermediate points via Palo Cedro, Millville, Forks of the Road, Kilarc and Whitmore seeks authority from this Commission to discontinue all his service and for a further order revoking his operating right.

Applicant's service, by authority of this Commission, was under suspension from August 6, 1934 to April 1, 1935 and on the last named date he was granted a further extension of suspension to and including April 1, 1936. It is now alleged that conditions have failed to improve and that further operation under the circumstances would not be profitable.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that David E. Covey be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property as a highway common carrier between Redding and Fern and intermediate points via Palo Cedro, Millville, Forks of the Road, Kilarc and Whitmore and all tariffs and time schedules now on file therefor be and they are hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 24840 dated June 6, 1932 on Application No. 18180 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
