SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission's attention having been directed to certain errors and inadvertences in Exhibit "A" of its Decision No. 28632 of March 16, 1936, in the above entitled proceeding and it being of the opinion that they should be corrected but that this is a matter not requiring a public hearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Exhibit "A" of Decision No. 28632 of March 16, 1936, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended as follows:

Original Page 12:

Change rating of Cement, building, from "3" to "5".

Original Page 20, Item 40:

Change 4th Class rate for over 200 to 350 pounds from ".47" to ".50".

Original Page 23, Item 85:

Add to note, "not subject to Rule 25".

Add under heading "Commodity Rates" a new item:

"Commodities transported for wholesale hardware houses in quantities of not less than 1000 tons per calendar month

City Deliveries and Inhaul. \$.07 per 100 pounds
Minimum charge.25 per shipment.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects
Decision No. 28632 in the above entitled proceeding as amended by
Decision No. 28731 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on May 1, 1936.
