O P I N I O N

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has filed with the Commission, revised sheets C.R.C. Nos. 483-G to 525-G, inclusive, to supersede and take the place of all of said utility's existing gas schedules. It has requested that these revised schedules be made effective on May 1, 1936 on less than the regular thirty days' notice.

The revised schedules are no higher, but in certain instances are lower, than those found reasonable in Decision No. 26512 of this Commission in 1933.

It is estimated that these new schedules will effect a gross reduction in gas revenue of approximately \$2,510,000 per annum. To a slight degree they result in an increase of rates to certain small users, but such increases are in conformity with the schedules found reasonable by the Commission in said Decision No. 26512. All are of the opinion that in so far as the schedules result in increased rates such increases are justified.

C O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and it is hereby authorized to publish upon less than thirty (50) days notice, effective May 1, 1936, revised schedules of rates for the service of gas, being C.R.C. Nos. 483-G to 525-G, filed April 23, 1936.
