O R D E R

In this application, E.T. Williams, as Trustee of the Estate of Austin Resort and Land Company, a corporation bankrupt, and by order of Hon. J.W. Kingren, Referee in Bankruptcy, granted on the 20th day of April, 1936, as set forth in the certified copy thereof in Paragraph 4 attached to the application herein, asks for authority to sell and convey to J.T. LaBree of Clearlake Highlands, Lake County, California, all of the property, both real and personal, including the certificate of public convenience and necessity, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, and, after investigation, it appearing that it is in the best interests of the public to approve this transfer and that no public hearing in this proceeding is necessary, now, therefore


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E.T. Williams, as Trustee of the Estate of Austin Resort and Land Company, a corporation bankrupt, be and he is hereby authorized to sell and convey to said J.T. LaBree the public utility water system heretofore op-

erected by said Austin Resort and Land Company, a corporation bankrupt, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before the first day of July, 1936, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by E.T. Williams, as Trustee of the Estate of Austin Resort and Land Company, a corporation bankrupt, within thirty (30) days from and after the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which said E.T. Williams, as Trustee of the Estate of Austin Resort and Land Company, a corporation bankrupt, actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
