SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Commission under date of January 13, 1936, rendered its Opinion and Order No. 28495 in the above entitled matter, approving the special agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and H. C. Capwell Company dated November 5, 1935, relating to the furnishing by the former and the purchasing by the latter of electric service for a minimum term of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company and the H. C. Capwell Company now make request for a supplemental order approving a modified agreement entered into April 24, 1936, a copy of which has been filed with the Commission, and which amends said agreement as hereinafter set forth:

- (1) The rates and charges to be paid by H. C. Capwell Company for electric energy and service to be furnished under said agreement of November 5, 1935 (except emergency lighting service), shall, from and after the 3rd day of February, 1936, be in accordance with Pacific Gas and Electric Company's filed schedule C-4, which schedule was effective January 1, 1936, under Advice No. 211.

- (2) All energy delivered and received pursuant to the provisions of the said agreement shall be what is commonly designated as four-wire, star, three phase, sixty cycle, alternating current and shall be delivered and metered at an electro-motive force of approximately 120-208 volts, slight variations in frequency and electro-motive force to be allowed.

AND IT APPEARING to the Commission that this is not a matter on which a hearing is necessary and GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and H. C. Capwell Company approved by Commission Order 28495 is hereby modified as set forth under paragraphs (1) and (2) above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects the provisions in the original order of Decision 28495 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
