ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company filed the above-entitled application requesting authority to abandon its non-agency station of Fleming, near University Avenue, Berkeley, in the County of Alameda, and to remove the shelter shed located at said station.

The application states that no business has been handled at said station during the past two years and that said station and shelter shed are not now required or likely to be required in the future.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Fleming, Alameda County, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station; and to abandon and remove the passenger shelter shed located at said station of Fleming.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
