

Decision No. 28861.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

for authority to (a) abandon the non-
agency stations of Camp Grant, Morani
and Bolt, all in the County of Humboldt,
State of California, and (b) to abandon
and remove a spur track at each station.

ORDER

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, on May 12, 1936, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency stations of Camp Grant, Morani and Bolt, in Humboldt County, and to remove spur tracks located at said stations.

Applicant alleges that no freight or passenger business has been transacted at said stations during the past two years and that said stations and spur tracks are not now required, or likely to be required, in the future for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation on May 22, 1936, signified in writing that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Camp Grant, Morani and Bolt, in Humboldt County, to eliminate said non-agency names from its station records, to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate

tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations, and to abandon and remove the spur tracks now located at said stations.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
