O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company filed the above entitled application requesting authority to install crossing signals of the so-called A.R.A. flashing light type at grade crossing of Third Street with its tracks at Tule Lake, Siskiyou County (Crossing No. CFA-529.8).

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary; that the signals proposed will give proper protection at said crossing; and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to protect Crossing No. CFA-529.8 by installing two (2) flashing light signals, commonly known as the A.R.A. type of signal.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
