J. J. Taylor, operating under the name and style of the Big Basin Line, hereby petitions the Commission for authority to discontinue, for a period of six (6) months, his common carrier automotive service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Santa Cruz and Big Basin via Boulder Creek as acquired under authority of Decision No. 25288, dated October 24, 1932, on Application No. 18412.

Applicant alleges that he lacks finances to furnish and operate equipment for this service and further shows, through the medium of "Exhibit A" a statement of revenues and expenses from Annual Reports attached to and made a part of his application, that the net loss from operations in 1934 and 1935 amounted to \$232.50.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, the application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. J. Taylor, operating under the name and style of Big Basin Line, be and he hereby is authorized

to suspend all service as an automotive common carrier of passengers, baggage and express between Santa Cruz and Big Basin via Boulder Creek, as acquired under authority of Decision No. 25285, dated October 24, 1932, on Application No. 18412, for a six (6) months period ending November 8, 1936, provided, that applicant shall immediately file and make effective, on five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, a supplement to his tariffs and a time schedule showing suspension of service as herein authorized and provided further, that applicant shall, on or before the expiration of said period, either resume his service or relinquish his operating right.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
