**ORIGINAL**O P I N I O N

Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc., a corporation, seeks authority from this Commission to reroute its existing service between Hayward and San Francisco as it applies particularly to the specific route set down in paragraph six (6), page seventeen (17) of the typewritten copy of Decision No. 23244, dated December 31, 1930, on Application No. 16989.

Applicant alleges that because of restrictions on parking on Castro Street between A and B Streets in front of its depot at Hayward, the present routing in paragraph six (6), aforementioned, can be used only by its busses enroute from Oakland to Livermore; in the opposite direction, from Livermore to Oakland, it is necessary to use Laurel Street and A Street between North Hayward (the junction of A Street and Laurel Avenue with State Highway route leading through Castro Valley and into Dublin Canyon) and Castro Street, in Hayward hence the instant application to permit the use of Laurel Avenue and A Street in addition to the present route via the extension of B Street between Hayward and the Dublin Canyon Highway route.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc., be, and it is hereby, authorized to reroute its existing service between San Francisco and Hayward by the amendment of section six (6) on page seventeen (17) of the typewritten copy of Decision No. 23244, dated December 31, 1930, to read as follows:

"Between Hayward and North Hayward the route in either direction to be via the extension of B Street (Hayward), or via Laurel Avenue and A Street, depending upon operating conditions."

In all other respects Decision No. 23244, shall remain in full force and effect together with all restrictions and conditions imposed therein.
