FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant herein having requested permission to construct a temporary detour crossing required in connection with the construction of the grade separation heretofore authorized in this proceeding, with grades of approach in excess of those specified in Decision No. 28786, dated May 4, 1936, and it appearing that this request is reasonable and should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant is hereby authorized to construct a temporary crossing with the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, identified as Crossing No. 4-13.9, with grades of approach in excess of those specified in said Decision No. 28786.

In all other respects Decision No. 28786 shall remain in full force and effect.
