OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application of the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement dated February 12, 1936, made and entered into by and between applicant and Frank Millich. A copy of the agreement, marked Exhibit "A," is attached to and made a part of the application.

Under the terms and conditions, and during the period specified in the agreement, applicant has agreed to install the necessary gas main extension and deliver and sell to Frank Millich, and the latter has agreed to purchase from the former, all the surplus natural gas which said Frank Millich shall require for the operation of his dehydrator, (subject to restriction under which such surplus gas is sold) located at a point approximately 500 feet west of the north end of Oak Road, near Campbell, Santa Clara County, State of California.

The aforementioned agreement provides for service and the payment for all surplus gas at rates in accordance with applicant's published tariffs, as well as with the Special Conditions contained therein except as to the period of the contract. The three-year period specified in said published tariffs is extended to five years by this special agreement.

The agreement contains a provision that it shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the Railroad Commission of the State of California as said Commission may from time to time direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

The extension of the contract period, as stated above, is fully warranted in order to justify the free gas main extension and, as said agreement is in the interest of both parties, it is the opinion of the Commission that this application should be granted and, further, that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above mentioned agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Frank Millich, dated February 12, 1936, be and the same is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
