SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 28400, dated December 2, 1935, Los Angeles Railway Corporation was granted authority to reroute its Fairview Heights motor coach line for a trial period of ninety days, which was subsequently extended by Decision No. 28719 to July 1, 1936.

Applicant now states that it desires to continue the rerouting for another period of ninety (90) days and requests a further extension of time.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles Railway Corporation is hereby authorized to extend the trial period of rerouting its Fairview Heights motor coach line, as authorized in Decision No. 28400, to October 1, 1936, subject to the conditions stated in said Decision No. 28400.
