ORDER

West Coast Wharf & Storage Company, a corporation engaged in the operation of a public warehouse for the storage of grain and other commodities at Oakland, having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to issue and sell 10 shares of its common capital stock of the par value of \$1.00 each, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for is reasonably required for the purposes specified herein, and that the expenditures for such purposes are not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, therefore.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that West Coast Wharf & Storage Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to issue and sell, at par for cash, on or before September 30, 1936, 10 shares of its common capital stock of the par value of \$1.00 each and of the aggregate par value of \$10.00, and to use the proceeds to pay in part organization expenses and indebtedness, provided-

1. That the authority herein granted shall become effective upon the date hereof; and

2. That applicant within thirty(30) days after such issue of stock shall file with the Commission a report such as is required by General Order No. 24, which order, insofar as applicable, is made a part of this order.
