FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record, and good cause appearing,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 28928 of June 29, 1936, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended by adding the following rates:
