O R D E R

In this application A. E. Ruda, engaged in the business of supplying water for domestic use in the Town of Avila, San Luis Obispo County, California, requests that the Railroad Commission of the State of California, make its Order authorizing said Ruda to transfer said water system, together with the equipment described in the application herein as follows:

"Two tanks, one 3 horse-power electric motor, tri-plex symplex pump and all pipe and fittings now in use in the operation of said system, together with all other pipe, fittings and fixtures not now in use but belonging to said system."

to John Farris, who joins in the application, and, after investigation, it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A. E. Ruda be and he is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to John Farris his water system in the Town of Avila, San Luis Obispo County, together with

the equipment as set forth above, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before the first day of September, 1936, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by A. E. Ruda within thirty (30) days from and after the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which said A. E. Ruda actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, A. E. Ruda shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
