## ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a certain agreement entered into by and between Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Antelope Creek Dredging Company, in words and figures as set forth in the copy thereof marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to Antelope Creek Dredging Company, as an accommodation and without dedication of same to public use for mining purposes, such quantity of excess water available in Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Red Ravine Canal, in Placer County, if and when requested, but not exceeding aflow of fifty (50) miner's inches (1), to be paid for at a rate of sixteen cents (40.16) per miner's inch day (2), said water to be used on certain property located in the southwest quarter (SW) of the southeast quarter (SW) of Section 33, Township 12

<sup>(1)</sup> For the purpose of this agreement a miner's inch shall mean one and one-half (12) cubic feet of water per minute.

<sup>(2)</sup> A miner's inch day for the purpose of this agreement shall mean one miner's inch of water as heretofore defined flowing for a period of twenty-four (24) hours.

North, Range ? East, M.D.B.& M., in Placer County, California, said agreement to be effective for a period of one (1) year from and after the date of its execution and thereafter until terminated at the election of either Pacific Gas and Electric Company or Antelope Creek Dredging Company by service on the other party of written notice to that effect thirty (30) days in advance of the date on which such termination shall become effective; and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; now, therefore,

pany, a corporation, and Antelope Creek Dredging Company be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
