THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Numerous requests having been received for the exclusion of certain commodities from the application of minimum rates established by Decision No. 28761, dated April 27, 1936 (39 C.R.C. 732) in this proceeding, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following commodities be and they are hereby excluded from the application of the minimum rates established by said Decision No. 28761:

MILK, CREAM, BUTTERMILK, COTTAGE CHEESE, POT CHEESE AND UNFLAVORED ICE CREAM MIX, when transported in milk shipping cans, in bottles in cases or crates, or in bulk in tanks;

FRESH FRUITS, other than fresh pears originating at points in Lake County not more than 20 miles distant by highway from Lakeport;

FRESH VEGETABLES.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission shall

and it does hereby retain jurisdiction in this proceeding for the purpose of establishing or approving the just, reasonable and non-discriminatory maximum and minimum or maximum or minimum rates, charges, classifications, rules and regulations to be charged, collected and observed by Radial Highway Common Carriers and Highway Contract Carriers, both for transportation service hereinabove described and for other transportation and accessorial services as may from time to time appear proper in the light of other or further evidence received herein.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
