 W. H. PIMENTEL, doing business under the
 fictitious name and style of North
 Sacramento-Stage Line, for a certificate
 of public convenience and necessity to
 operate an automotive passenger stage
 service between Haggin Oaks Store and the
 Army Air Base, both points being in
 Sacramento County, over and along the
 following route: Haggin Oaks Store to
 22nd Street, to North Avenue, to 24th
 Street, to South Avenue, to Army Air Base,
 returning via same route, or via Ben Ali-
 Antelope Road to Ben Ali, as an extension
 to the existing rights of applicant to
 operate automotive passenger stage ser-
 vice between Sacramento, California, and
 Haggin Oaks Store, and intermediate points
 and to consolidate the existing rights of
 applicant with the operative right herein
 sought.
