 applicant was authorized to resume service between Oakland and
 San Lorenzo only and

WHEREAS, it now appears that demand upon the carrier
 requires resumption of service between San Lorenzo and Palo Alto
 via San Lorenzo Junction and Leidig and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Peerless Stages, Inc., be
 and it is hereby authorized to resume service between San Lorenzo
 and Palo Alto via San Lorenzo Junction and Leidig and to refile
 tariffs and time schedules therefor provided that the authority
 herein granted shall in no wise be construed to grant to applicant
 any or more rights than those heretofore encompassed in the
 decisions referred to herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
