OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding the Railroad Commission is asked to make an order authorizing the transfer of the warehouse business and equipment located at Sacramento, heretofore operated by Jennie Travis and Arthur E. Travis, copartners under the fictitious name of Western Van and Storage Company, to Arthur E. Travis, an individual, in accordance with a Bill of Sale, a copy of which is on file in this proceeding. The transfer is by consent of both parties and no monetary consideration is involved.

Applicant Arthur E. Travis will continue to operate the warehouses as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown in Warehouse Tariffs Nos. 1 and 2, C.R.C. Nos. 1 and 2, and supplements thereto. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. Jennie Travis and Arthur E. Travis, copartners, shall join in common supplement to the tariffs now on file with the Railroad Commission in name of Western Van and Storage Company, applicants Jennie Travis and Arthur E. Travis, copartners, on the one hand withdrawing and applicant Arthur E. Travis, an individual, on the other hand accepting and adopting such tariffs and all effective supplements thereto.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased, transferred or assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer or discontinuance has first been secured.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
