OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants seek an order authorizing the transfer by William Irwin, doing business under the firm name and style of Irwin Grain and Milling Company, to Irwin Milling Company, a non-profit cooperative association duly organized and incorporated under the Agricultural Code of the State of California, of the warehouse business located at No. 400 South Aurora Street, Stockton, California.

The operative right was created by William Irwin as result of filing of Warehouse Tariff No. 1, C.R.C. No. 1, effective August 26, 1935. The transfer is by consent of all parties concerned and no monetary consideration is involved. Applicant Irwin Milling Company will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown in Warehouse Tariff C.R.C. No. 1. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted; therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. William Irwin and Irwin Milling Company shall join in common supplement to the tariff now on file with the Railroad Commission in name of Irwin Grain and Milling Company, applicant William Irwin on the one hand withdrawing and applicant Irwin Milling Company, a non-profit cooperative association, on the other hand accepting and adopting such tariff.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased, transferred or assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer or discontinuance has first been secured.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
