O P I N I O N

G. C. Celio, applicant herein, requests permission to discontinue all service for the automotive transportation of passengers as a Common Carrier between Nevada City and Murchie Mine and Hoge Mine. Applicant also requests a further order revoking his operating right for this service.

As justification for the granting of such authority, applicant alleges that the Hoge Mine has closed down and that workmen in the Murchie Mine are using their own cars for transportation purposes. He further has stated in a letter to the Commission that no operations have been conducted in 1936.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that G. C. Celio be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all service for the automotive transportation of passengers as a Common Carrier between Nevada City and Murchie Mine and Hoge Mine and his time schedule and tariff for such service are hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that decision No. 25406,
dated November 29, 1932, on application No. 18528 be and the same
is hereby revoked and annulled.
