The TURN BACK CREEK LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, a
corporation, has filed with the Commission revised sheets as
follows:

It is requested that these revised schedules be
made effective on September 1, 1936, on less than the regular
thirty days' notice.

The justification for the proposed new filing is that
proposed new schedules of rates will place the domestic and commer-

cial consumers of applicant substantially on a rate parity with similar classes of consumers of other utilities in adjacent territory and will, except as hereafter stated, result in substantial decreases in rates to such consumers of applicant.

The proposed new rates will cause certain increases, which applicant represents are of a technical rather than of an actual nature. Such increases are represented to be:

- (a) For small domestic and commercial lighting consumers using 7 to 15 Kwh. in any month, the maximum increase is approximately 20¢ a month.
- (b) For heating and cooking consumers the change in the minimum requirement is but a possible technical increase as no existing consumers will be affected under their present installations.
- (c) For general power consumers, the omission of one power block will affect no present consumers as none are large enough to avail themselves of the block withdrawn.

It is estimated that the revised schedules will effect a saving in excess of 10% or approximately \$1600 per annum. We are of the opinion that in so far as these schedules may result in increased rates such increases are justified.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that TURN BACK CREEK LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY be and it is hereby authorized to publish on less than thirty days' notice, effective September 1, 1936, revised schedules of rates and rules and regulations for the service of electricity, being C.R.C. Nos. 32 E, ~~33 E~~, 26 E, 27 E, 28 E, 29 E, 30 E, 31 E, ~~32 E~~ and ~~33 E~~, *N.M.* filed August 20, 1936 under Advice No. 5.
