

Decision No. 23101

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of MARKET STREET RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for Removal of Tracks on Sixth Street from Mission Street northerly to Market Street, across Market Street to Taylor Street, and along Taylor Street to Post Street, and on Post Street from Leavenworth Street to Market Street, in the City and County of San Francisco.

## ORDER

Market Street Railway Company, a corporation, on September 2, 1936, applied for authority to remove its tracks on Sixth Street from Mission Street northerly to Market Street, across Market Street to Taylor Street and along Taylor Street to Post Street, and on Post Street from Leavenworth Street to Market Street, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

Applicant alleges that it has entered into an agreement with the City and County of San Francisco for the removal of said tracks and the abandonment of service upon and along said tracks.

The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, by Ordinance No. 15.09117 and by Resolution No. 2613 authorized the removal of said tracks and the abandonment of said service.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Market Street Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue street car service

and remove its tracks upon and along Sixth Street from Mission Street northerly to Market Street and along Taylor Street to Post Street, and upon and along Post Street from Leavenworth Street to Market Street, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, subject, however, to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment herein authorized.
- (2) Applicant shall give the public not less than five (5) days' advance notice of the abandonment of service on the line involved herein, by posting notice in all cars operated thereover.
- (3) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
