OPINION AND ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Helene W. Eichbaum herein seeks authority from this Commission to discontinue and abandon all service for the automotive transportation of passengers, baggage and express as a common carrier between Lone Pine and Stove Pipe Wells and requests a further order revoking her operating right therefor.

In justification of the granting of such authority, applicant alleges that there has been practically no business at all over this line and her annual report for 1935 filed with the Commission states that there has been no operation for that period except that one passenger was carried.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Helene W. Eichbaum be and she is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon all automotive service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express as a common carrier between Lone Pine and Stove Pipe Wells and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and the same hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 15360 dated January 15, 1926 on Application No. 11823 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
