## <u>O R D E R</u>

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on September 16, 1936, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Pumork, San Mateo County.

Applicant alleges that no freight business was transacted during the last two years at said station, and that, in its opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Pumork in San Mateo County, State of California, to eloiminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
