SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, by our Decision No. 15281 in the above numbered application of Balies C. Walker, dated August 12, 1925, this Commission authorized applicant "to suspend operation of the auto stage service established by him under authority of the Railroad Commission on Application No. 9432 until further order of this Commission"; and

WHEREAS, the suspension was predicated upon the desire of applicant to suspend said operations pending the enactment by the Congress of the United States of legislation governing interstate commerce by auto stage, and

WHEREAS, such legislation is now enacted and in effect,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant herein shall on or before October 27, 1936, resume the passenger stage operations heretofore certificated by Decision No. 13311, dated March 24, 1934, on Application No. 9432, under schedules and tariffs to be filed on or before said October 27th therefor; provided, however, that applicant shall in lieu of restoring such service show good cause why such service should not be restored at a public hearing

conducted by Examiner W.R. Williams at the Court House in the City of El Centro at 10.00 O'clock A.M. on October 27, 1936.
