ORDER

The Willow Creek telephone line is a small telephone property serving a few subscribers in the vicinity of Paso Robles. The present application alleges that La Rue Smith has succeeded to the properties and that the estimated value thereof is \$500. A public hearing not being required and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that La Rue Smith, operating under the fictitious name of Willow Creek Telephone Company, is hereby authorized to adopt and render service under the rates, rules and regulations now on file with the Railroad Commission pertaining to this service; provided that within twenty (20) days from the date hereof he file with the Railroad Commission his written acceptance of the authorization herein granted.
