

Decision No. 29205.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of
NORTHWESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY
for authority to (a) abandon the non-
agency station at Manila, in the County
of Humboldt, State of California, and
(b) to abandon and remove a spur track
approximately 384 Feet in length, lo-
cated at said station.

ORIGINAL

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, on October 9, 1936, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Manila, located in Humboldt County, and to remove a spur track located at said station, all as shown on the blue print map attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that no freight business was transacted at said non-agency station during the past three years, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on October 13, 1936, signified, in writing, that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of

Manila in Humboldt County, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station; and to abandon and remove a spur track located at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
