WHEREAS the Commission has been advised under date of October 12, 1936, of the death of Mr. Biggs on February 1, 1936, and

WHEREAS the aforomentioned communication from his widow, Edna H. Biggs, contains the further information that, for more than a year prior to his death, Mr. Biggs had failed to operate under said certificate and

WHEREAS it now appears that no further attempt will be made to continue the operation of the Atlas Mail and Stage Line

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore issued to C. H. Biggs, operating under the name and style of Atlas Mail and Stage Line. be and it is hereby declared to have been abandoned and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and they hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 11584, dated February 3, 1923, on Application No. 8618 be and it is hereby revoked and annulled.
