ΔN Decision No. 29245BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA In the Matter of the Application of The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing at grade Application No. 20733 of the state highway and the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway, at a point one quarter mile westerly of Valencia Avenue, in the County of Orange, State URIGINAT of California. BY THE COMMISSION: FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER In Decision No. 29164 in the above entitled application, the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, were authorized to construct a crossing at grade with the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, in the vicinity of Valencia Avenue, Orange County. Said Decision provided that the crossing authorized, be protected by two Standard No. 4 wigwags as specified in the Commission's General Order No. 75-A. The Pacific Electric Railway Company under date of October 22, 1936 has requested that said Order be modified to permit the installation of horizontal flashing light signals attached to the mast of the Standard No. 4 wigwags. It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant in the above entitled proceeding and Pacific Electric Railway Company are hereby authorized, in addition to the Standard No. 4 wigwag signals heretofore ordered in Decision No. 29164 on the above entitled application, to install horizontal flashing light signals attached to the mast of said Standard No. 4 wigwags.

In all other respects Decision No. 29164 shall remain in full force and effect.
