No. 156236 of October 2, 1936. No increase is involved insofar as California intrastate traffic is concerned.

Upon further consideration of the record and of the supplemental application filed November 4, 1936, and in view of the decision of the Interstate Commerce Commission in its Special Permission No. 156236 of October 2, 1936, we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the relief sought should be granted, subject to the conditions and exceptions set forth in the original order in the above entitled application as modified herein or by prior supplemental orders; and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the supplemental application filed November 4, 1936, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby granted, subject to the conditions in the original and prior supplemental orders, and only for the period ending December 31, 1936.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
