SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 27526, dated November 13, 1936, in the above entitled application, Southern Pacific Company was granted authority to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of 46th Avenue in the City of Oakland. Said crossing was not at that time constructed and the order was permitted to lapse. Southern Pacific Company, on October 23, 1936, filed a supplemental application in this proceeding requesting that the authority granted in said Decision No. 27526 be extended for a period of one year from date.

It appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 46th Avenue, Oakland, as heretofore authorized in Decision No. 27526 in this application and subject to all the conditions of said Decision excepting that the limit of time for the construction of said crossing under this authority shall be one year from the date of the instant order.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
