SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By this supplemental application Fialer's Inc., seeks an amendment to its certificate of public convenience and necessity as granted in decision No. 25227, dated October 3, 1932, and subsequently amended by decisions Nos. 26263 and 26469, dated August 21, 1933, and October 23, 1933, respectively, so as to permit of operation of its automotive common carrier passenger sight-seeing service via the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge as an alternate route and in addition to its currently conducted operation via the ferries of the Southern Pacific Golden Gate Ferries, Ltd.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

THEREFORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Fialer's Inc. by decisions Nos. 25227, 26263 and 26469, dated October 3, 1932, August 21, 1933 and October 23, 1933, respectively, be and it is hereby amended so as to permit applicant to operate as a common carrier of passengers for sightseeing purposes via the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge as an alternate route only and in addition to operation via the

ferries of the Southern Pacific Golden Gate Ferries, Ltd., and subject to all the limitations and restrictions heretofore imposed by the aforementioned decision which are hereby declared to remain unchanged and in full force and effect except for the alternate routing feature herein authorized.

The following conditions will apply:

1. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the amended certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed fifteen (15) days from date hereof.

2. Applicant shall file and make effective on not less than one (1) days notice to the Commission and the public, a supplement to its tariff and a time schedule conforming to the amended certificate herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
