## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The application herein prays that with the opening of the transbay bridge on or about November 12, 1936, they be permitted to utilize said bridge as an alternate route and in addition to the use of the ferries.

We believe that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority requested and that a public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Wm. H. Smith and Makin H. Smith, Jr. operating under the name and style of Transbay Motor Express Co. is hereby granted permission to operate across the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge between San Francisco and Oakland via the transbay

bridge as an alternate route and in addition to the use of the ferries of the Southern Pacific-Golden Gate Ferries, Ltd. It is expressly understood that the permission hereby granted does not in any manner enlarge applicants, existing operative rights and that its operations remain subject to all conditions and limitations attached to their existing rights except as to the deviation in route hereby authorized and provided that applicant shall file and make effective on one (1) days notice to the Commission and the public a supplement to their tariff and a time schedule reflecting the authority herein granted.
