SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER.

Applicant Joe Ferrant, operating under the name and style of Airdrome Transport as a common carrier of airline passengers and their baggage now operates his passenger vehicles across San Francisco Bay between San Francisco and Oakland via the ferries of the Southern Pacific Golden Gate Ferries, Ltd. The application herein prays that with the opening of the transbay bridge on or about November 12, 1936, he be permitted to utilize said bridge as an alternate route and in addition to the use of the ferries.

We believe that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority requested and that a public hearing is unnecessary.

THEREFORE good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Joe Ferrant is hereby granted permission to operate his passenger vehicles across the San Francisco Bay Bridge between San Francisco and Oakland via the transbay bridge as an alternate route and in addition to the use of the Southern Pacific Golden Gate Ferries, Ltd. It is expressly understood that the permission hereby

granted does not in any manner enlarge applicant's existing operative rights and that its operations remain subject to all conditions and limitations attached to its existing rights except as to the deviation in route hereby authorized and provided that applicant shall file on one (1) days notice to the Commission and the public a supplement to his tariff and a time schedule reflecting the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
