authority to (a) abandon the non-
agency station of Moulton, in the

ornia, and (b) to abandon and remove
the spur track approximately 465 feet
in length, located at said Station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on October 26, 1936, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Moulton, located in Santa Clara County, and to abandon and remove a spur track located at said station as shown in yellow on a blue print map attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that no business has been transacted at said non-agency station for several years and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency and spur track is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on November 2, 1936, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Moulton, in Santa Clara County, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records; to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules apply-

ing at said station, and to abandon and remove the spur track located at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
