FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, party at interest in the above numbered application, on November 12, 1936 filed its request that Condition (4) of Decision No. 29197, dated October 19, 1936, be amended to provide for the installation of flashing light signals at the crossing of Milliken Avenue over its main line track in the vicinity of Guasti Station, County of San Bernardino, in lieu of Standard No. 3 wigwag signals as provided in said Condition (4).

Southern Pacific Company alleges that due to sand and wind conditions in the vicinity of said crossing, flashing light signals would be preferable to Standard No. 3 wigwag signals.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (4) of Decision No. 29197 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (4) Two (2) flashing light signals (commonly known as A. R. A. flashing light signals) shall be installed for the protection of said crossing;

at the sole expense of applicant. Their maintenance thereafter shall be borne by Southern Pacific Company.

In all other respects Decision No. 29197 shall remain in full force and effect.
